

DNS Junior Naturalist Field School Registration Information

Schedule

9:00 am – 3:00 pm daily

- ∞ Session I: June 9 – 13, 2008
- ∞ Session II: June 16 – 20, 2008
- ∞ Session III: July 14 – 18, 2008
- ∞ Session IV: July 21 – 25, 2008

Location

All field school activities will take place at the 142-acre Durango Nature Center near Bondad, Colorado, situated along the Florida River just above the confluence with the Animas River. The diverse landscape at the Nature Center includes prairie dog colonies, meadows, piñon-juniper forests, desert arroyos, sage-rabbit brush habitat, and river/pond wetlands.

Ages and Number of Students

Junior Naturalist Field School is limited to 8-12 participants in each age group:

- ∞ Bobcats: Students ENTERING 1st or 2nd grade this fall
- ∞ Lynx: Students ENTERING 3rd or 4th grade this fall
- ∞ Mountain Lions: Students ENTERING 5th or 6th grade this fall

NOTE: Please honor these age designations so that we may give all students the best experience possible.

Cost

The fee for the DNS Junior Naturalist Field School is \$125 for one week per child. The fee includes all instruction, activities and supplies.

Transportation

Optional transportation is provided for campers between Durango and the Durango Nature Center for an additional fee of \$25 per week per child. The van leaves the Centennial Center (Office Depot) parking lot at 8:30 am sharp and returns at 3:30 pm each day.

Meals

Campers must provide lunch, drinks, and snacks. Durango Nature Studies will have plenty of water available.

Registration

Registration is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. A waiting list will be formed after each group is filled. To reserve your child's spot, send a completed registration form and full payment (including additional transportation fees if applicable) to the address on the registration form. You will be notified upon receipt of your payment.

Payment

In order to reserve your child's spot, payment by check or money order for the full amount must be received one week prior to camp.

Cancellation Policy

If you need to cancel, refunds will be granted one week prior to the start of the session. After that, refunds will be made if your child's place is filled by someone on the waiting list less a \$25 cancellation fee. In the event DNS must cancel, refunds will be made in full.
